Western Stevedoring has put into place a number of initiatives to substantially reduce emissions from Terminal equipment in an effort to protect the environment and minimize health risks.

Western Stevedoring operates some of the most modern, environmentally friendly equipment available. The company has in place a program for replacing older, less efficient equipment and is actively involved in the testing of alternative fuels and additives.

The intent of the Anti-Idling Policy is to reduce emissions from equipment that is idling unnecessarily. All Equipment Operators, Truck Drivers and Supervisors are responsible for ensuring that this policy is adhered to when operating mobile equipment and vehicles at Lynnterm.

This means:

- Lift Trucks and Tractors
 - Mechanics must keep pre-shift warm-up times to a minimum.
 - Drivers must shut down Lift Trucks and Tractors during all breaks and during any idle periods.
- Pick-up Trucks
 - Operators must be advised to keep warm-up times to a minimum.
 - Pickups must be turned off during all breaks and when parked and left unattended.
- Truck Drivers
 - Trucks must be shut down when they are parked or stopped in the yard.

Western Stevedoring asks for your cooperation in assisting the Company in the reduction of emissions and protection of the Environment.
