

**WESTERN STEVEDORING COMPANY LIMITED
PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT POLICY
HOODED GARMENTS**

Hooded garments have a high potential to limit visibility and decrease hearing.

For the safety of all employees:

- At no time should hooded garments be worn with the hood up in Warehouses, while working RoRo vessels or Car Carriers, or operating any equipment including pick-up trucks.
- It is highly recommended that hooded garments are not worn over your head during vessel or terminal operations as hoods can restrict vision, especially to the side and above.



This Policy applies to all Western Stevedoring Management, Staff, Superintendents, Foremen, Regular Workforce, Despatched Workforce and any other person required to enter a materials handling area at a Western Stevedoring Terminal and/or who are required to board a berthed vessel at any terminal. Non-compliance with this policy could result in disciplinary action up to and including termination.
