Western Stevedoring and its subsidiaries (collectively, the “Company”), its management and staff, ensures that all Company sites including but not limited to Lynnterm, Squamish, Victoria Cruise Ship & Deep Water Terminal, Cowichan Bay, and BCVPC comply with the security provisions as determined by Federal Legislation and the International Ship and Port Facility Security Code (ISPS Code).

Complying with the security provisions is accomplished through increased and improved security systems and the provision of security awareness training at prescribed frequencies. Improvements in security systems are achieved through fixed and mechanical intrusion barriers and detection devices. Security Awareness Training is both generic and terminal-site specific.

Every employee of the Company and its subsidiaries has a responsibility for ensuring that the facilities are securely maintained.

- Squamish Terminals – General Manager
- Victoria Cruise Ship and Deep Water Terminal – General Manager
- Cowichan Bay – Terminal Manager

- BCVPC – Manager
